2014 Public Examination results

Once again, CTC has had a pleasing set of public examination results. At A2 level, over 52% of all grades were at A* and A which is very impressive and has enabled our students to gain places at the very best Universities such as Oxford, Cambridge, UCL and Imperial. In fact almost 90% of all grades were at A* to C. As soon as we know where our leavers have gone, we will publish their destinations on the website.

We have also had a *very* encouraging set of AS results which bodes well for our students' results next year which is really good. Rest assured that we will continue to ensure our students work hard to attain those top grades.

At GCSE, our results were very much as expected with 40% of all grades at A*/A, well above the national average.

My congratulations go to all students who worked so hard to get their grades and to my teaching colleagues for their dedication in preparing them so well.

College Development

Over the summer holidays we have upgraded the Wi-Fi provision and speed throughout the College and installed brand new suite of fast all-in-one PCs for the students use, together with iMacs for Art. The new Reception area is almost complete, despite the Contractor going bust over the holidays which has not helped. The Student Common Room, which I have been so keen to upgrade, is behind schedule as we found a rather serious water issue under the floor which must be fixed before we can relay it. It has been very frustrating.
